Breakfast and snacks served.

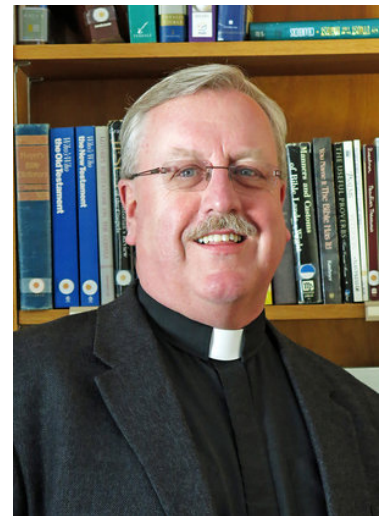
Buffalo Burrito Project:
