DAILY

SCRIPTURE READING



Do you want to know more about God's plan for all life, how God's justice works, or why we exist at all? What questions would you ask about God's nature, about human nature, about the soul or good and evil or any of the big questions?

By engaging with scripture we hear the voice of God speaking to us through inspired people who were moved to record their experience and their love of God and share with all of us who would come after them. God's Word is life and with our lives rooted in it we can experience spiritual growth.

The Challenge:

Once a day this week take time to read John 9:1-41.

- 1. Pray for God's Word to be transformative rather than informative.**
- 2. Read the text. Stop frequently, asking, "what does this passage tell me about God? How does what I hear fit with what I know about Jesus' teaching, life, death, and resurrection? What life lesson is here for me?"**
- 3. Pray for the Holy Spirit to help you conform your attitudes and behaviors to what you've received.**
